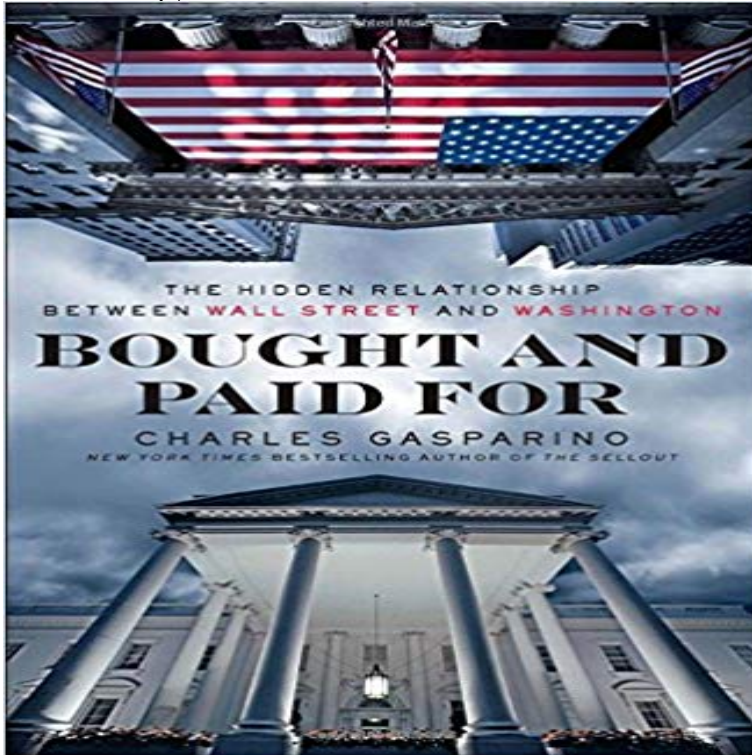


# Bought and Paid For: The Hidden Relationship Between Wall Street and Washington
