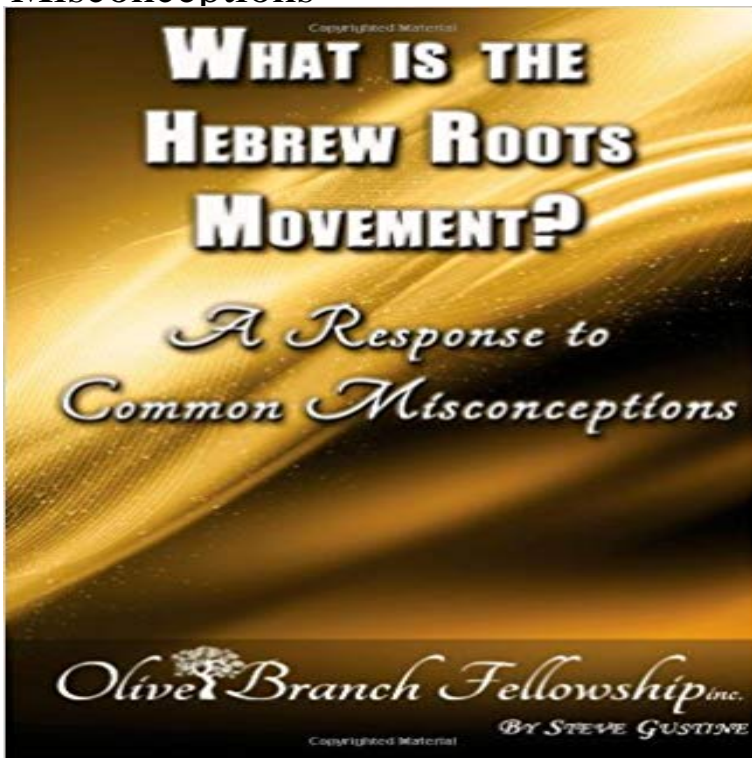


What is the Hebrew Roots Movement: A Response to Common Misconceptions

But as I dug in, the Spirit of God revealed something to me that was hidden for over 30 years of my life.
