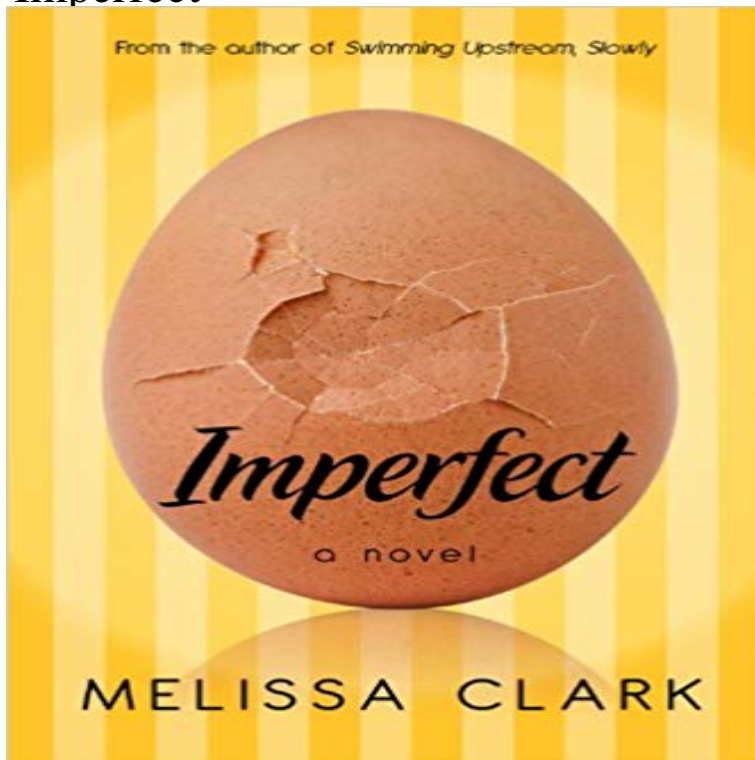


Imperfect
