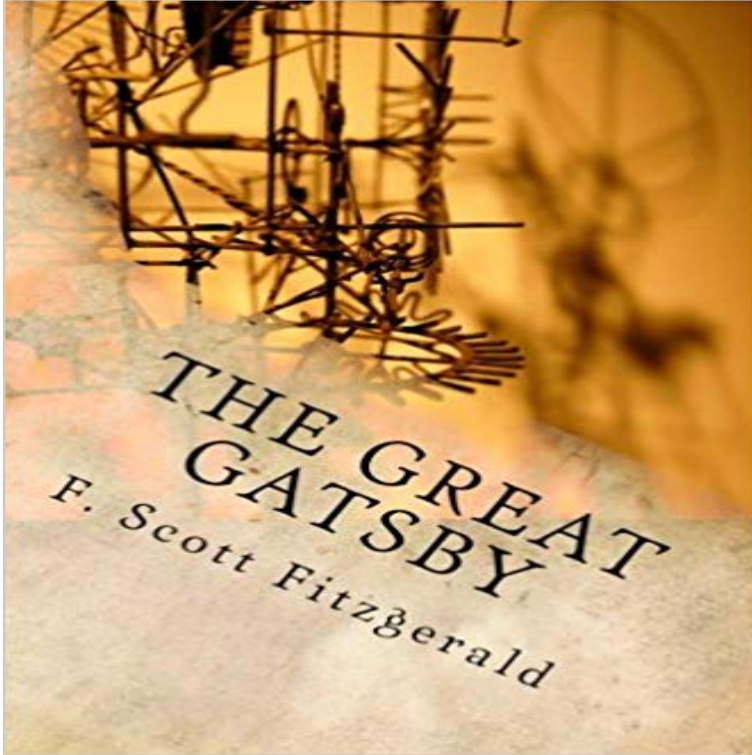


The Great Gatsby
